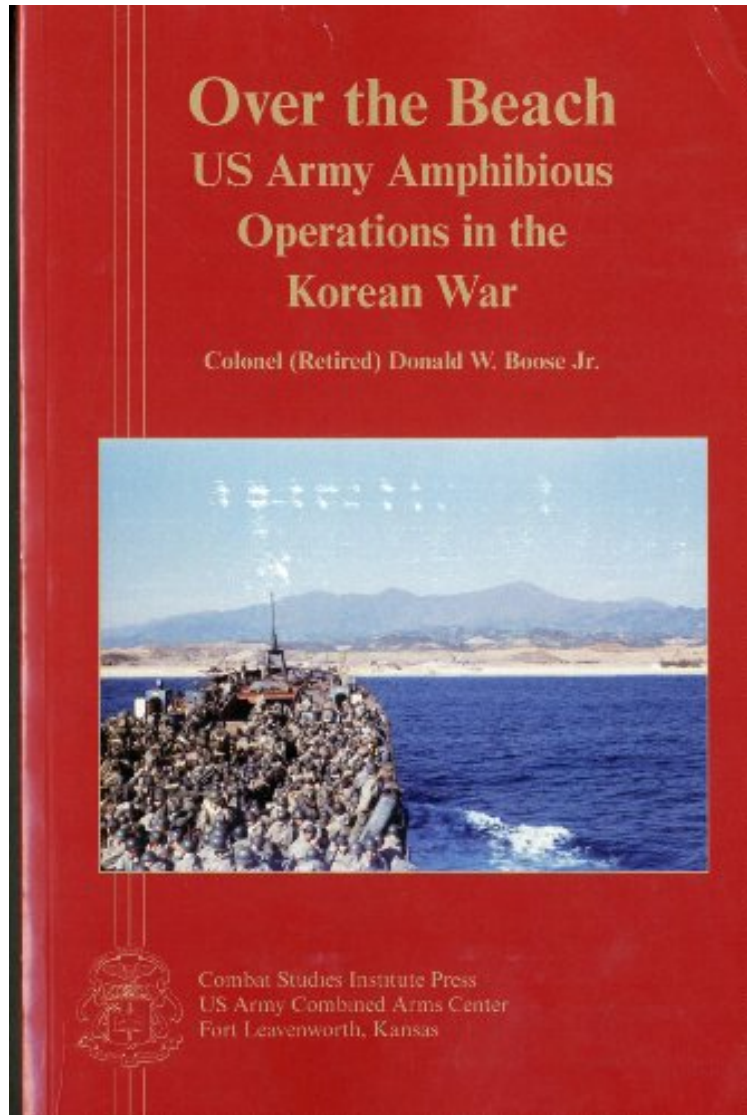

His treatment of the Army's largely unheralded amphibious operations during the Korean War is similarly excellent. If you thought that the Inchon landings were solely a USMC affair, think again.
