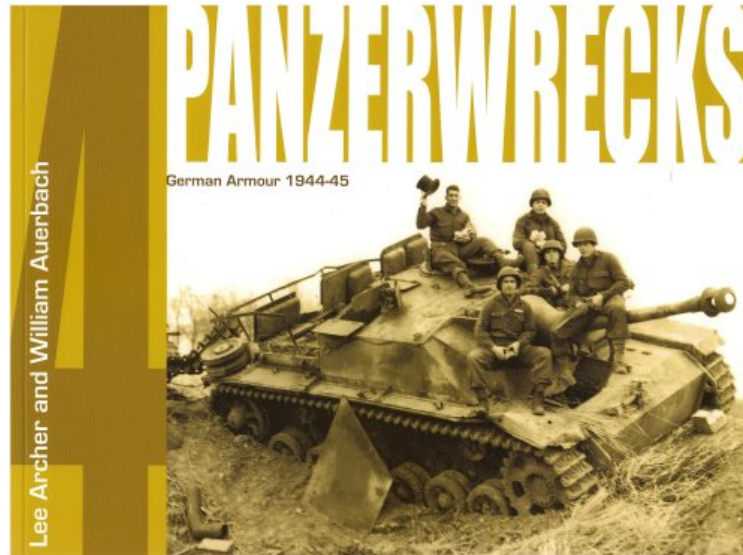

These magazines offer the German Panzer Tank enthusiast the best source for historical photographic reference. Written by two of the most well known authors in the field, Lee Archer and William Auerbach, you'll find each edition full of pictures. Many of them full page and most all of them accompanied by paragraphs containing details, including timelines/dates, individual vehicle details and exact locations. Panzerwrecks 4 is a first rate photo book for fans of late war German armor who desire large photos for their modeling and research projects. Its 96 pages contain 116 rare and unpublished photos from archives and veterans' photo collections around the world, all reproduced as large as possible for maximum clarity. Comprehensive captions provide proper identification of units, vehicles and locations as well as comments on a vehicle's color, camouflage and markings. Readers will find a wealth of material on both the Eastern and Western Fronts during the pivotal years 1944-45. Featured in this fourth volume are photos of all variants of the Sd.Kfz.234 series of the heavy eight-wheeled armored cars, including the one mounting a 'Luchs' turret!
