It is a worthy addition to your library.This work is notable from three points of view. First, as others have noted it is a military story about partisan warfare, spirit and dedication. Dodd is a model soldier, a wonderful example.Next, it is a painless primer on the Peninsular War. What was it like? Not too nice. (Sharps's Gold also deals with this war.)Finally, it is a standalone book by Forester, the writer of the Hornblower series. Through his resourcefulness, fortitude and "never quit" attitude he survives a Winter organizing Portuguese resistance fighters and harassing the French. While starved and without supply, he preserves his weapon and uses it on occasion as a sniper. I don't know if there is an actual foundation for which the story was built on but it

is motivating, none the less.
