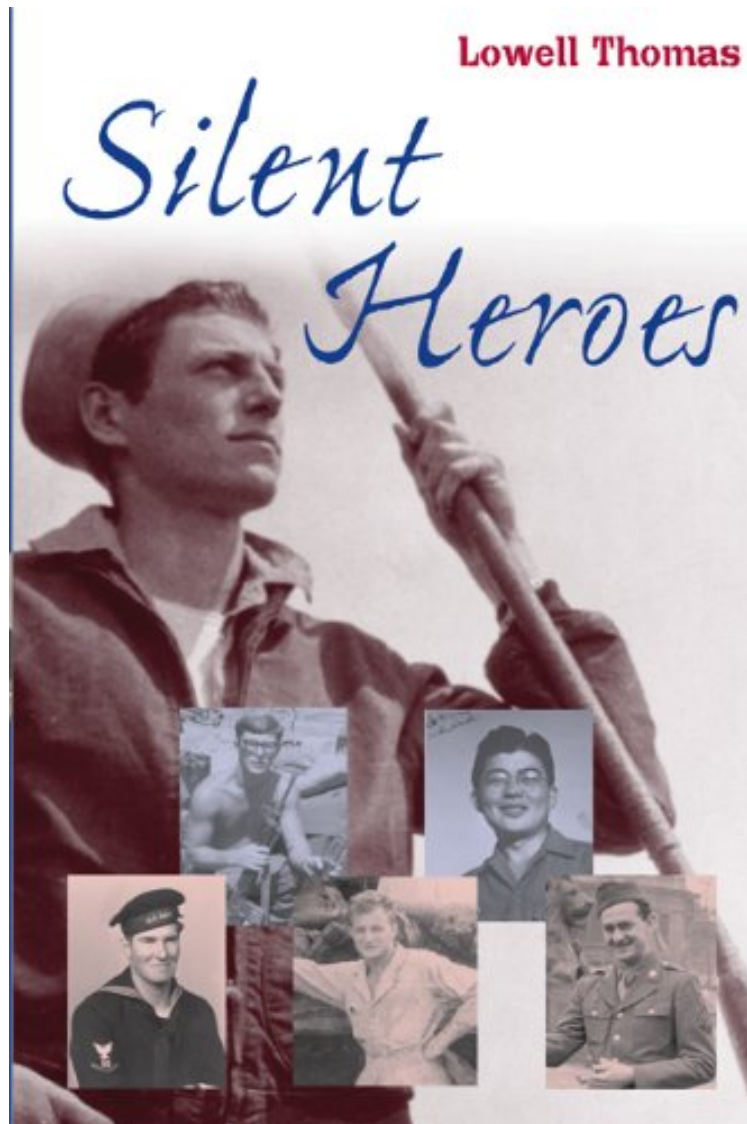

He was a co-founder of the Literacy Council of Midland County, Inc.
